RE: Facility Use

Dear Ms. Arnott-Brykes:

This is to put into written form the request I presented to you yesterday.

As part of our work, the Federal Division of the Prosecutor's Office makes arrangements for court ordered paternity testing. Our testing facility, Orchid Cellmark, sends phlebotomists to Macomb County once a month to draw the appropriate parties. We currently use the Southeast Macomb Health Department's rooms for these drawings and as a waiting area. We had previously been at the main Health Department in Clinton Township.

Several times in the last few months we have had to call the St. Clair Shores Police Department to come out and separate arguing and fighting parties. Some of these disturbances involved parties to a case, some involved friends or families parties brought with them. We have tried, unsuccessfully, to restrict attendance to parties only. We also cannot provide security or limit access to that public building or public area. The activities of the belligerents are dangerous to persons visiting the Health Department for other reasons.

I am requesting monthly use of space in the County Building, 10 North Main. There are several advantages to this location: everyone entering the building must go through the metal detecting portal, past the "blue coat" officers; there are deputies available for deterrence and to provide security if needed; staff from this office will limit entry to the waiting area; an inside office can be used for draws; and Mount Clemens is a central location. If possible, being on the same floor as the Sheriff's Department-Civil Division would provide visible security to deter problems. I understand that the First Floor will soon be under construction, but a similar area on another empty floor would work too. That we were temporally set up on another floor at first would not be a problem.

Currently we schedule 30 to 35 trios each month. If the new location does not resolve the confrontation problems we may have to add a second day per month if Orchid can accommodate us. We also have testing cases sent to us by Juvenile Court and private attorneys.

Since we spoke yesterday, James Langtry, Prosecutor's Office, received a call from Steven Gold, Health Department Director, indicating that the Health Department can no longer

accommodate us and needs us to relocate our drawing site. We may be able to do our December 13, 2010, draw there, but we have to get out.
